- CSI is one of the 18 Colleges of the City University of New York. CUNY is the largest urban public university in the United States with more than 450,000 students. (WWW.CUNY.EDU)
- CSI is a commuter college with a current enrollment of 12,422 students.
  - 60% are full time. 90% are undergraduates.
  - 61% of our students are female. 63% are under 24.
  - 75% live on Staten Island and 20% live in Brooklyn.
  - 70% are white and non-Hispanic.
- CSI has 776 Faculty. 341 are Full Time.
